1	After testing of soil through Bore Log it was found that out of 11.21 km more than 8.5 km of land falls under Marshy area. So, it is impossible for anyone to construct the above-mentioned road work at the given cost of the project. To execute the project work soil treatment is required first which will automatically increase the cost of the project	<p>The bidders are advised to go through the scope of work detailed in schedule B wherein clause 4(i) of Schedule B mentions that construction of embankment/cut section shall conform to the specification & standards given in section 4 of the manual. Section 4 of the manual inter-alia stipulates that the contractor shall carry out necessary survey & investigation, identify problematic ground locations, if any requiring treatment for finalising structural features and design of embankment and cut section and establishing improved ground properties.</p> <p>Therefore, the identification of problematic ground location requiring treatment & improving ground properties for embankment/cut section is included in scope of work.</p> <p>Bidders are also advised to refer to clause 2.5 of the RFP and make their own assessment to Improve ground conditions and quote their rates accordingly</p>
