

**2<sup>nd</sup> Minutes of Meeting of Empowered Technical Bid Evaluation Committee  
(ETEC)**

Date: 13.02.2019 at NHIDCL (HQ).

**Name of work:** Restoration of Road by providing & laying of WBM-III, Bituminous Macadam & Bituminous Concrete including construction of Protection walls, Cross Drainage works from Km 80.000 to Km 170.000 (Kishtwar - Chatroo) on Batote-Kishtwar-Sinthanpass road in the State of Jammu & Kashmir. (Package-II)

It was noted that ETEC in its earlier meeting dated 07.02.2019 had recommended that the clarifications, as suggested by the financial consultant, be sought from the bidders. After the approval of the Competent Authority, the bidders were requested to clarify the observations pertaining to their respective bids. It was noted by the Committee that all the three bidders submitted the replies to the observations.

- i. M/s Shiva Buildtech Pvt. Ltd.
- ii. M/s SRM Contractors Pvt. Ltd.
- iii. M/s Khandey Infrastructure Pvt. Ltd.

2. ETEC further noted that the minimum eligibility/qualification criteria as per RFP are as under:

3. Financial consultant vide their report dated 12.02.2019 examined the clarifications received from the bidders as per the requirement of RFP (Annexure-I).

ETEC observed the following in respect of each bidder:

**3.1 M/s Malik Construction Infra Pvt. Ltd.**

3.1.1 ETEC noted that as per the report of the financial consultant, none of the project falls in the category of eligible project or the work has not been done for the Govt. entity. As per the qualification requirement of bidder as per the clause 4 of RFP, the bidder is required to submit the experience certificate in accordance with



clause 4.2 (c) of the RFP. Since none of the claimed project qualifies under the eligible category. ETEC is of the opinion that the bid of **M/s Malik Construction Infra Pvt. Ltd.** is non-responsive in terms of clause 4.4.A (b) of the section -II of RFP and should not be considered for financial opening as recommend by the financial consultant.

### 3.2 **M/s Shiva Buildtech Pvt. Ltd.**

3.2.1 The bidder has replied to the queries vide letter no. nil dated 08.02.2019 (Soft and Hard Copy) which were examined by the financial consultant and the replies were found to be in order and the bid submitted by **M/s Shiva Buildtech Pvt. Ltd** was found to be responsive and met the eligibility criteria. Financial consultant recommended the bidder as qualified for the next stage of the bidding process. ETEC agreed with the recommendation of financial consultant.

### 3.3 **M/s SRM Contractors Pvt. Ltd.**

3.3.1 The bidder has replied to the queries vide letter no SRM/Tendering/2018-19/308 dated 09.02.2019 (Soft and Hard Copy) which were examined by the financial consultant and the replies were found to be in order and the bid submitted by **M/s SRM Contractors Pvt. Ltd.** was found to be responsive and met the eligibility criteria. Financial consultant recommended the bidder as qualified for the next stage of the bidding process. ETEC agreed with the recommendation of financial consultant.

### 3.4 **M/s Khandey Infrastructure Pvt. Ltd.**

3.4.1 The bidder vide letter no KIPL/Clerif.80-170/2018-19-1 dated 09.01.2019 replied (Soft and Hard Copy) to the queries which were examined by the Financial Consultant. Financial consultant in his report submitted that as per RFP clause 4.4 (b) of section II Instruction to Bidders , to qualify for award of the contract the bidder should have satisfactorily completed (not less than 90% of contract value), as a prime contractor, similar works during last five years ending last day of month previous to the one in which bids are invited, at least one Highway (Road/or Bridge Works)/ Airport runway of 40% of the value of contract (i.e. Rs. 1180.23 Lakh).

3.4.2 The project "*Restoration of road by way of clearance of landslide, surface boulders side drain, culverts including construction of R/wall and B/walls and laying of WBM-I, WBM-II, WBM-III & Bituminous Carpeting on Sinthanpass- Anantnag -Khanabal road (Km 184.000 to Km 265.000) in the state of Jammu & Kashmir*" claimed by the bidder **M/s Khandey Infrastructure Pvt. Ltd.** as one of the eligible project is not completed and is under execution. The Project belong to NHIDCL and as per records the financial progress upto last IPC is Rs. 8, 60,34,554.00 i.e. 68.96%. Further Branch office has confirmed that no further IPC has been submitted by the contractor. The total financial progress upto last IPC The total contract amount is Rs. 12,47,70,022.00. (Annexure-II). Hence the project was not considered as it is not substantially completed as per RFP.

3.4.3 Financial Consultant examined the clarification and mention that Road Project i.e. Upgradation of Larkipora Zaidoora Lisser Road from Km 1 to Km 11 (**Average width 5.50 m**) in Dist Anantnag is not National Highway or state Highway, hence cannot be considered as eligible project. ETEC is of the opinion that the bid of **M/s Khandey Infrastructure Pvt. Ltd.** is non-responsive in terms of clause 4.4.A (b) of the section -II of RFP and should not be considered for financial opening.

4. The following was observed by the ETEC regarding the qualification of each bidder whose bids were technically responsive:
