**Minutes of Meeting of Empowered Technical Evaluation Committee (ETEC) held on 24.11.2017 for "Consultancy Services for Authority's Engineer for supervision of "(i) Rehabilitation and up-gradation of Tura-Mankachar road from Mirjumala junction to Mankachar-Silchar Tinali (0/0 to 1/660km) to two lane carriageway in the State of Assam, (ii) Rehabilitation and up-gradation of Doimukh-Harmuti road from Harmuti Junction (0/00 km) to Khula camp (14/370 km) and Doimukh (0/000 km) to Bagh Tinali (3/100 km) two lane carriageway in the State of Assam and Arunachal Pradesh, (iii) Rehabilitation and up-gradation of Wokha-Merapani Road from Wokha Junction (0/000 km) To (26/000 km) in the State of Nagaland, (iv) Rehabilitation and up-gradation of Wokha-Merapani Road from (26/000 km) To (48/000 km) in the State of Nagaland (v) Rehabilitation and up-gradation of Wokha-Merapani Road from (48/000 km) To Merapani (60/585 km) in the State of Nagaland and Assam"**

In this meeting on 24.11.2017, the ETEC examined the comments of M/s Indian Technocrat Limited on the revised technical evaluation results in light of the already uploaded details captured in the Moved Data. In connection with the claim of M/s Indian Technocrat Limited for enhancement of marks of Mr. Alok Kumar proposed for the position of Senior Quantity Surveyor by the firm, the ETEC observed that in the input sheet there are two designations of Quantity Surveyor for making selection of similar capacity designation to any Key Personnel. While selecting the similar capacity designations for the post of Senior Quantity Surveyor, one out of the two designations of Quantity Surveyor was inadvertently left unselected in the input sheet. It implies that if a Key Personnel has uploaded a project on INFRACON against the unselected designation of Quantity Surveyor, that project will not be considered in evaluation. As such, some of the projects of Mr. Alok Kumar (as detailed in **Annexure-I & II**) were not considered by INFRACON for evaluation of score. Hence, the ETEC manually evaluated the score of Senior Quantity Surveyor of all the three firms after considering the left-out projects due to non-selection of one Quantity Surveyor designation on INFRACON. The ETEC observed that score of Senior Quantity Surveyor of M/s Indian Technocrat Limited i.e. Mr. Alok Kumar has changed from 40 to 90 due to manual evaluation as detailed on **Annexure-III** whereas, there is no effect on the score of proposed Senior Quantity Surveyors of other two firms.

2. Further, ETEC examined the claim of M/s Indian Technocrat Ltd. for enhancement of marks against "Employment with the Firm" of two Key Personnel viz. (i) Mr. Sandireddy Lakshmi Kantha Reddy (proposed for the position of Material Engineer) and (ii) Mr. Shailesh Kumar Jha (proposed for the position of Team Leader cum Senior Highway Engineer). The ETEC observed that as per the uploaded data on INFRACON, Mr. Sandireddy Lakshmi Kantha Reddy and Mr. Shailesh Kumar Jha has worked in Indian Technocrat Ltd. from 01.06.2012 to 13.09.2017 and 01.02.2011 to 14.09.2017, respectively but another entry has also been made for their continuation in the firm. As such, INFRACON has picked up 0 year employment with the Firm. However, based on the comments provided by M/s Indian Technocrat Limited, the Committee examined the furnished Salary Slips of both the Key personnel for the month of October, 2017 provided by M/s Indian Technocrat Limited

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as a documentary proof for their current employment with the firm and accepted the claim of bidder that both the Key Personnel are currently working with M/s Indian Technocrat Limited. Since, the Employment of both the Key Personnel is more than 5 years as on Bid Due Date, the ETEC enhanced the score of both the Key Personnel manually by 5 marks.


3. Based on the manual correction in scores of Senior Quantity Surveyor, Team Leader cum Senior Highway Engineer and Material Engineer, the revised "Abstract of Key Personnel Score" of M/s ITL is attached as Annexure-IV.

4. Further to the revision made in the score of M/s Indian Technocrat Ltd., the summary of evaluation results is given below:
