Minutes of Meeting of Empowered Technical Bid Evaluation Committee (ETEC) to evaluate technical bid for “CONSULTANCY SERVICES FOR AUTHORITY’S ENGINEER (2nd Call) FOR (i) Construction of (i) 154m span Steen Superstructure Bridge at Km 145.09 over River Barak and (ii) 122 m span Steel Superstructure Bridge at Km 189.80 over River Makru on Jiribam- Barak road on NH-53 in State of Manipur (Pkg-I). (ii) Short Term Improvement & Routine Maintenance of Imphal-Jiribam Road from Km 3.00 to Km 220.00 (Length= 217 Km) of NH-53 (New NH-37) in the state of Manipur on Percentage Rate basis (Pkg-II). (iii) Restoration/Reconstruction of Tamenglong-Khonsang Road (Km 0.00 to Km 39.50) in the State of Manipur(Pkg-III)” at NHIDCL on 10.11.2017, New Delhi-Technical Evaluation- reg.

- 1) The RFPs for the subject work were invited on 14.09.2017 with bid due date as 01.11.2017 till 1500 hrs.
- 2) In all 02 proposals (based on data uploaded on Infracon portal) were received from the following consulting firms. The envelopes containing bid document cost, bid security, Power of Attorney etc were opened accordingly thereafter by ETBC in the presence of Bidders representative who choose to attend
 - a) M/s Indian Technocrat Limited
 - b) M/s Highway Engineering Consultant
- 3) Further the ETBC decided to evaluate the Technical Bids through INFRACON, however it was observed that there is no provision for Stage-I evaluation of standalone bridge criteria as per RFP through INFRACON Portal. Hence the first stage evaluation for ascertaining the Proof of Eligibility was carried out manually in accordance to Clause 11 of SECTION 1: INFORMATION TO CONSULTANTS of RFP (Annexure A) and the details is as under:

- 4) The second stage evaluation was carried out through the Infracon evaluation module (~~Annexure B~~) and the results obtained from Infracon portal are as under:

5) However, since there is no provision for evaluation of standalone bridge criteria as per RFP through INFRACON Portal, hence the marks for Firm's Relevant Experience has been calculated manually as per the information furnished on Infracon Portal (Annexure B). The marks for Qualifications and Competence of the Key Staff for the assignment have been calculated through Infracon portal (Annexure C). The revised score is as under:

6) The committee deliberated the evaluation through INFRACON in detail and observed following:

a) It can be seen from Para 4 above that the technical score of proposal of all the aforesaid 2 (Two) eligible bidder is more than 75 marks out of 100 marks. Hence, responsive as per clause 5.3 of Letter of Invitation (LOI) of RFP.

b) The score of Team Leader cum Sr. Bridge Engineer cum Road Safety expert of all the aforesaid 2 (Two) eligible bidder is more than 75 marks out of 100 marks. Hence, responsive as per clause 3.4 (iv) (f) of Letter of Invitation (LOI) of RFP.

c) **M/s Indian Technocrat Limited**

The technical score of Highway Engineer cum Pavement Specialist and Bridge/Structural Engineer cum Material Engineer is less than minimum qualifying marks i.e. 75 marks, however we may ask the bidder during negotiation to give a replacement for the key professional who has scored less than 75% marks by a person of at least 75% score as per para iv (f) of Clause 3.4 of Letter of Invitation (LOI) of RFP.

d) **M/s Highway Engineering Consultant**

The technical score of Highway Engineer cum Pavement Specialist and Bridge/Structural Engineer cum Material Engineer is less than minimum qualifying marks i.e. 75 marks, however we may ask the bidder during negotiation to give a replacement for the key professional who has scored less







than 75% marks by a person of at least 75% score as per *para iv (f) of Clause 3.4 of Letter of Invitation (LOI) of RFP.*

- d) On INFRACON vide circular dated 05.07.2017 it has been informed that the Debarment Order dated 18.05.2017 in favour of M/s Highway Engineering Consultant Bhopal issued by Govt. Of Telangana, has been stayed till 19.07.2017 by Hon'ble High Court of Hyderabad. However it is bought out that stay of the Debarment of M/s Highway Engineering Consultant has initially been continued till 28.07.2017 and further extended till 09.11.2017 by Hon'ble High Court, however the final outcome is awaited.

- 7) Keeping in view Para 5 to 7 above, all the 02 (Two) bidders are found technically qualified and eligible for opening of financial bids. The details of score are as under:

b) M/s Highway Engineering Consultant
