

Minutes of Meeting of Empowered Technical Evaluation Committee (ETEC) for Evaluation of technical bid for “Consultancy Services for Carrying out Feasibility Study, Preparation of Detailed Project Report and providing pre-construction services in respect of (i) 2 laning with paved shoulder of Churachandpur -Tuivai road section (length 162Km) on NH-102B in the State of Manipur (ii) 2 laning with paved shoulder of Imphal-Jiribam section of NH-37 (NH-53) (length 220 Km) in the State of Manipur (iii) 2 laning with paved shoulder from Tamenglong in Manipur to Peren in Nagaland via Longdi Pabram (length-100Km) (2nd Call)” at NHIDCL, New Delhi on 21.08.2017-**Technical Bid Evaluation- reg.**

- 1) The RFPs for the subject work were invited on 06.06.2017 with bid due date as **31.07.2017** till 1700 hrs.
- 2) In all 06 proposals (based on data uploaded on Infracon portal) were received from the consultancy firms as mentioned below. The envelopes containing bid document cost, bid security, power of Attorney etc were opened accordingly thereafter by Empowered Technical Bid opening Committee (ETBC) on 01.08.2017. Further the ETBC recommended evaluating the Technical Bids through INFRACON as per the provisions of RFP for the following participating firms.
 - a) **M/s C E Testing Company Pvt. Ltd.**
 - b) **M/s Global Infra Solution JV Krishna Techno Consultant Pvt. Ltd.**
 - c) **M/s S M Consultants.**
 - d) **M/s Highway Engineering Consultant**
 - e) **M/s Technocrats Advisory Services Pvt. Ltd.**
 - f) **M/s Eptisa Servicios De Ingeniera S.L.**
- 3) Having confirmed the acceptability of the submitted documents in reference to clause 5.1 of RFP document, the first stage evaluation for ascertaining the Proof of Eligibility was carried out through Infracon (as placed at Annexure-A) and the detail is as under.

- 4) Accordingly the second stage evaluation was carried out through the Infracon evaluation module for 6 (Six) aforesaid eligible bidders and the results (as placed at Annexure-B) are as under:

- 5) The committee deliberated the evaluation through INFRACON in detail and observed following:

- a) It can be seen from Para 4 above that the technical score of proposal of all the aforesaid 6 (Six) eligible bidder is more than 75 marks out of 100 marks. Hence the technical proposal of all the aforesaid 6 (Six) eligible bidders is complying the Clause 5.2 of Letter of Invitation (LOI) of RFP and has scored more than 75 marks. Hence, responsive.
- b) M/s Eptisa Servicios De Ingeniera S.L. Associated with Company M/s Stup Consultants Pvt. Ltd.

The technical score of Senior bridge engineer is less than minimum qualifying marks i.e. 75 marks, however we may ask the bidder during negotiation to give a replacement for the key professional who has scored less than 75% marks by a person of at least 75% score as per Clause 6.6 of Letter of Invitation (LOI) of RFP.

c) **M/s Global Infra Solution Associated with M/s Infycons Creative Software Pvt. Ltd. and Krishna Techno Consultants Pvt. Ltd**

The technical score of Senior bridge engineer and Highway cum Pavement Engineer is less than minimum qualifying marks i.e. 75 marks, however we may ask the bidder during negotiation to give a replacement for the key professional who has scored less than 75% marks by a person of at least 75% score as per Clause 6.6 of Letter of Invitation (LOI) of RFP.

d) **M/s Highway Engineering Consultant**

The technical score of Environmental specialist is less than minimum qualifying marks i.e. 75 marks, however we may ask the bidder during negotiation to give a replacement for the key professional who has scored less than 75% marks by a person of at least 75% score as per Clause 6.6 of Letter of Invitation (LOI) of RFP.

e) **M/s SM Consultant**

The technical score of Material cum Geotechnical Engineer is less than minimum qualifying marks i.e. 75 marks, however we may ask the bidder during negotiation to give a replacement for the key professional who has scored less than 75% marks by a person of at least 75% score as per Clause 6.6 of Letter of Invitation (LOI) of RFP.

f) **M/s C E Testing Company Pvt. Ltd**

The technical score of all the key personnel is more than minimum qualifying marks i.e. 75 marks. Hence, responsive.

g) **M/s Technocrats Advisory Services Pvt. Ltd.**

The technical score of all the key personnel is more than minimum qualifying marks i.e. 75 marks. Hence, responsive

6) On INFRACON vide circular dated 05.07.2017 it has been informed that the Debarment Order dated 18.05.2017 in favour of M/s Highway Engineering Consultant Bhopal issued by Govt. Of Telangana, has been stayed till 19.07.2017 by Hon'ble High Court of Hyderabad. However it is bought out that stay of the Debarment of M/s Highway Engineering Consultant has initially been continued till 28.07.2017 and further extended till 21.08.2017 by Hon'ble High Court.

7) Keeping in view Para 4 & 6 above, all the 06 (Six) bidders are found technically qualified and eligible for financial opening accordingly. The details of score are as under:
