Article 14, Maintenance, 14.1 Maintenance obligation of the Contractor	The Contractor shall maintain the Project Highway for a period of 4 (four) years commencing from the date of the Provisional Certificate (the "Maintenance Period"). For the performance of its Maintenance obligations, the contractor shall be paid 0.5%# of the Contract Price for the first year and 1%#, 1.5%#, 2%# of the Contract Price for the second, third and fourth year respectively in case of road projects. But in case of stand alone Bridge / structure work, the contractor shall be paid 0.25%, 0.5%, 0.5% and 0.5% of the Contract Price for the first, second, third and fourth year respectively. Amount shall be, inclusive of all taxes. The amount payable for maintenance shall be adjusted to reflect any increase or decrease arising out of variation in WPI to be determined in accordance with the provisions of Clause 19.12. For the avoidance of doubt, it is agreed that in the event no Provisional Certificate is issued, the Maintenance Period shall commence from the date of the Completion Certificate. It is further agreed that the Contract Price hereunder shall be reckoned with reference to the amount specified in Clause 19.1.1, which shall be adjusted to the extent of	The Contractor shall maintain the Project Highway for a period of 5 (five) years commencing from the date of the Completion Certificate (the "Maintenance Period") in case of road being constructed with flexible pavement, 10 (ten) years in case of road being constructed with Rigid pavements and 10 (ten) years from the date of completion for the stretches where new technology/material has been proposed to be used. For the performance of its Maintenance obligations, no separate payment is to be made to the contractor for carrying out maintenance works during defect liability period / maintenance period. The payment shall be made to the contractor during construction and Defect Liability Period in the following manner: (i) Payment during construction p eriod -90% of the total civil works cost. (ii) Payment after three years of construction in case of flexible pavements and after 5 years in case of Rigid Pavements – 5% of total civil works cost linking with performance parameters.
